School Outreach Coordinators were able to help students achieve the following results:

- ◆ 100% of seniors that worked with School Outreach Coordinators graduated high school
- ◆ 97% of high school students were promoted to next grade level
- ◆ 93% of middle school students were promoted to next grade level
- ◆ 88% improved/maintained academics
- ◆ 86% improved/maintained attendance
- ◆ 87% improved/maintained school behavior
- ◆ 97% improved/maintained social-emotional learning goals

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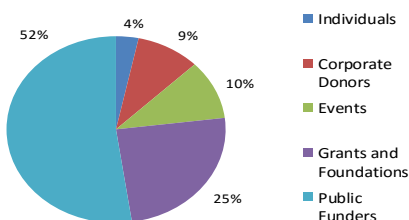

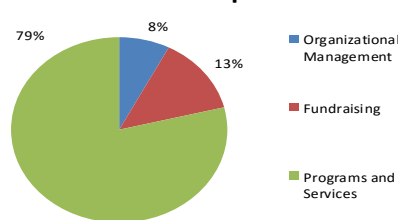


2014-2015 Income
